

GLACIER CREEK MIDDLE SCHOOL LOCK-IN – March 12, 2010

Following is important information regarding the 2009 lock-in scheduled for March 12, 2010. For security and safety reasons there are some general rules we would like to share with you and ask that you discuss these rules with your child.

The lock-in begins immediately upon dismissal of school. Students signed up to attend the lock in and not absent on March 12<sup>th</sup> that fail to check in at the lock-in will have a call placed to parents to inform them that the student is not in attendance as indicated by the permission slip.

Students will not be allowed to leave early or arrive late to the lock-in unless prior arrangements have been made. If your child needs to arrive late or leave early please call Sue Olson in the guidance office at 829-9428 to make prior arrangements.

If a student becomes ill or for any reason wishes to leave the lock-in early, a call will be placed to the parents/guardian who will need to come into the school to check the student out of the lock-in. For emergencies you may call the school that evening at 516-8206 or 576-4263.

Due to this being a secure, controlled environment and for the safety and enjoyment of the GCMS students, we cannot allow parent volunteers to have siblings or guests accompany them when volunteering. In general children, other than GCMS students signed up to attend the lock-in, are not allowed to enter the school during the lock-in.

If your child is performing in the talent show and you wish to attend the performance, we ask that you e-mail Lena Oberwetter, talent show parent coordinator @ [lco@polaw.com](mailto:lco@polaw.com) to be placed on a guest list. Due to limited space and an effort to control the size of this event, we ask that you please limit guests to immediate family only. If a sibling attends the talents show, we ask that they remain with you and not be allowed in other areas of the school. Guests of the talent show performers need to be pre-registered and will need to check in upon arrival and check out and exit the building immediately following the talent show.

We greatly appreciate your cooperation and understanding of these guidelines. It is our hope that we can again bring your students a fun and safe lock-in experience. Lock-in attendees will have the opportunity to get involved in various tournaments. Advance sign up is required for the basketball tournament, chess tournament and involvement in the talent show. Sign up will take place the week of February 16<sup>th</sup> during student lunch hours. There will also be opportunities throughout the evening for the students to get involved in a limbo contest, bingo, ping pong, open gym, crafting, karaoke, arcade games, board games, as well as a movie and a DJ dance to top off the evening. There will also be a special drawing and many prizes!

Students will be released and go to their lockers to retrieve their belongings starting with 6<sup>th</sup> grade at 9:40 pm, 7<sup>th</sup> grade at 9:50 pm, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade at 10:00 pm. Students will be released through the front entrance of the school. Because of the amount of traffic generated at the end of this event, we strongly suggest carpooling and to arrange a specific location to meet your child.
