Students and parents of Ski Club members:

Beginning in January 2010, we will be taking four ski club trips to Devils Head ski resort. The Glacier Creek Ski club is a chaperoned group of 6th, 7th and 8th grade students who either know how to ski or wish to learn.

Details:

Transportation will be provided to and from Devils Head ski resort. Students should be at Glacier Creek's parking lot to load busses by 4:45 each day of the trip. Please arrive 15 minutes earlier if you have equipment to load. The bus will leave promptly at 5:00 and return around 10:30. Students must be picked up by 10:45 or will not be allowed to attend future trips. The dates scheduled for this year are:

Jan. 8 Jan. 15 Jan. 22 Jan. 29
Possible make up date Feb. 5

***Students may register for one or more trips at a time. If you are planning to attend more than one trip, we would prefer that you fill out one sheet and pay for all trips you are attending at that time. We understand if you are not able to plan in advance.

If you are interested in chaperoning, put your name and phone number on the registration form. You will be contacted by Thursday of that ski week if we need you.

Please pay for each trip or for all trips attending by cash or check (made out to GCMS). Checks or cash must accompany your registration slip and other needed forms.

Costs for Each Trip:

1. \$30.00 for lift ticket, advisors, chaperones and transportation.
2. \$9.00 rental fee for skis or snowboards (see registration form)
3. \$5.00 fee for a lesson (see registration form)
4. \$2.00 helmet rental

3. Lift tickets and rental forms will be distributed as you get off the bus at the hill. Do not lose them. Treat them like cash.
4. Storage lockers are available at the hill. Bring quarters. Food is also available at the hill. Be aware that it is more expensive than bringing your own.
5. DRESS WARMLY. Ski with friends and keep track of the time. You are expected to ski in control and on the appropriate runs at all times. If any problem arises, find a chaperone immediately.
6. No food or drink on the buses. Students may not wear ski boots on the bus.
7. Students not cooperating with the rules in the student handbook, on this sheet or with chaperones will be barred from future ski trips.
8. Students picked up later than 10:45 pm will be barred from the next trip.
9. All injuries will be taken care of by Devil Head's ski patrol. Parents, guardians or other contact number will be notified at that time. If the need arises for further emergency service, the student will be transported by ambulance to the Baraboo hospital.
