Below is information regarding the High School Junior Varsity Wrestling Tournament to be held on Saturday, January 17, 2009.

Location: Middleton High School

Entries: You can bring as many wrestlers as you wish in each weight class.
ENTRIES MUST BE ENTERED USING TRACK WRESTLING by Friday, January 16 at 10:00 p.m. Each school has already received, via email, a username and password.

Weigh-in: 8:00 a.m. Coaches should have their teams organized to save time at weigh-ins.

Wrestling: All wrestlers will be put in four-man round robins, separating schools when possible as a priority, then grouped according to weight and skill level.

Coaches: All coaches will meet at 8:45 a.m. in Room 1701.

Locker Room Facilities: Will be assigned upon arrival. Each coach is responsible for the care of his team's equipment. Middleton will not be responsible for the loss of any materials.

Awards: Each team's ten (10) best individual scorers will comprise a team total. A trophy is awarded to the team with the highest total. First through fourth place wrestlers will receive custom medals and the champion will receive a wall chart.

Towels: Towels will not be provided. Each coach is responsible for his team.

Concessions: The Middleton Wrestling Club will be selling concessions throughout the day.

Entry Fee: There will be a \$100.00 entry fee for awards, hiring of officials, etc. Admission is \$4.00 for adults and \$2.00 for children.
